

Dr. Ledet Passes Boards

On December 2, 1975, in San Francisco, Dr. Arlo E. Ledet successfully completed the board examination in veterinary clinical pathology and was, therefore, certified as a veterinary clinical pathologist. In 1972 he was certified as a veterinary pathologist. There are only eight other veterinarians in the United States and Canada at the present time who are certified in both specialty areas.

Dr. Ledet joined the faculty at Iowa State University in 1962 after spending several years in general practice. He holds the rank of professor in the Department of Veterinary Pathology at Iowa State University and is in charge of the clinical

pathology laboratory. He has been most active in the teaching and continuing education programs of the College. Dr. Ledet's areas of interest in research include hematology and clinical chemistry. He is a member of many professional, honorary and scientific societies, among which are the Iowa and American Veterinary Medical Associations, American College of Veterinary Pathologists, Phi Zeta, Sigma Xi and Gamma Sigma Delta.
