History: 12 year old female St. Bernard was presented to the ISU Small Animal Clinic depressed, showing pain and a large swelling in the distal end of the right forelimb. She would not put weight on the leg. A tap produced bloody fluid. What's your diagnosis?

Answer: Radiographic and Post Mortem diagnosis: Lytic Fibrosarcoma
