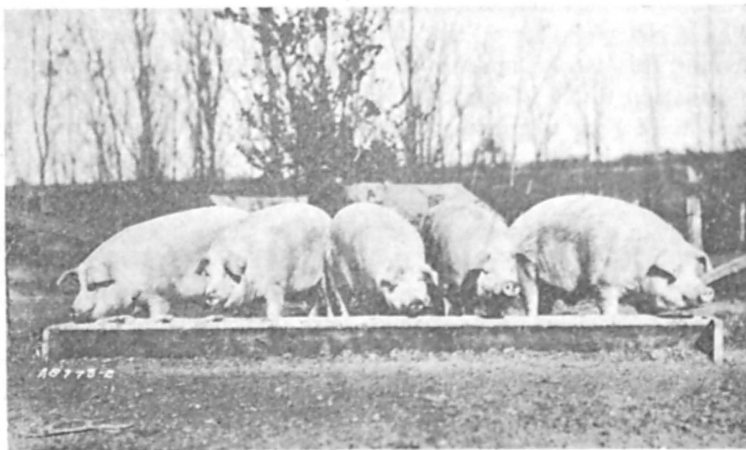

Many requests come to the Animal Husbandry Department of Iowa State College for information relating to the literature of the swine industry as well as for the names and addresses of swine registry and record associations. To supply this increasing demand this catalog and directory has been prepared to present information which is concise and up-to-date. The literature on swine husbandry is growing rapidly and many notable additions to the list of publications on this subject may be expected in the near future.

An organization with which swine men may well affiliate is the National Swine Growers' Association. The office of the secretary of this organization is located at Shenandoah, Iowa. This association is organized and maintained for the promotion of the swine industry. Membership may consist of any person, firm, corporation, or association, that is engaged in the breeding, raising, selling, or improvement of swine. Fees are nominal, and a copy of the by-laws may be obtained by writing to the secretary.

There are also special state and breed associations which are particularly interested in the promotion of different breeds of swine, as well as the swine industry. These are organized for the promotion and benefit of swine interests specific and general.
