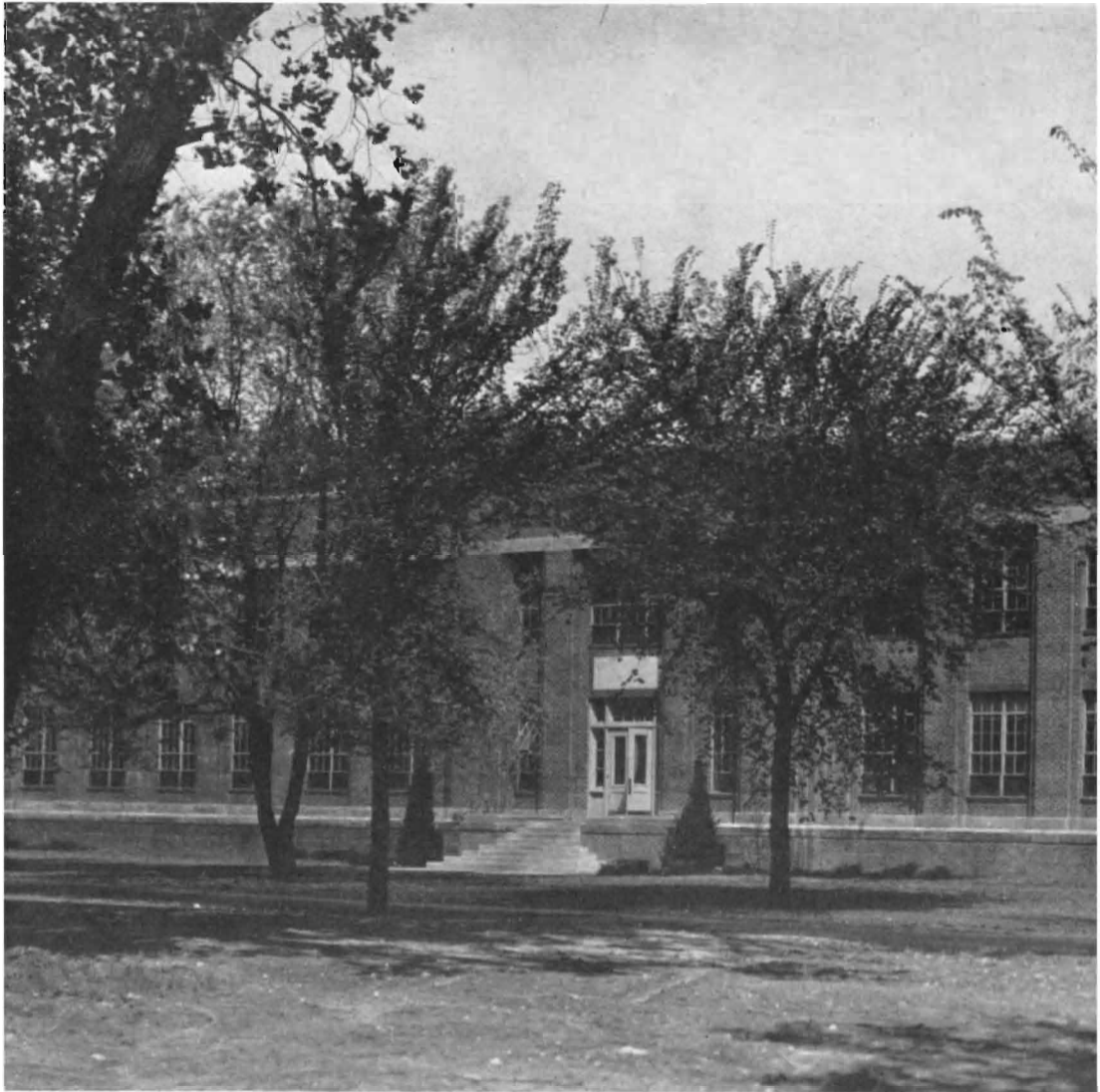
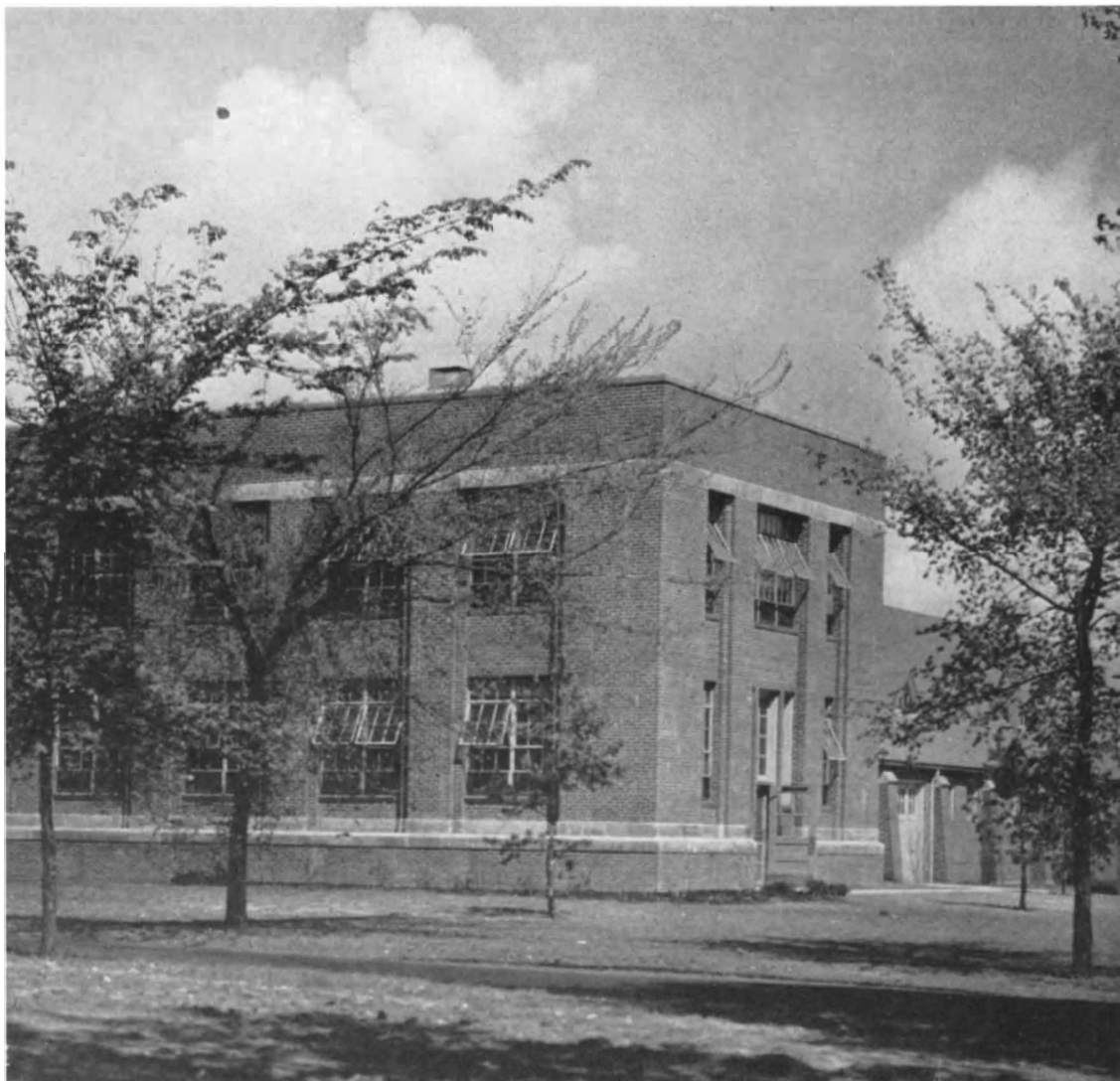

**Sanitary Building, later College Hospital and Music Hall, first building erected for the Veterinary Division.**



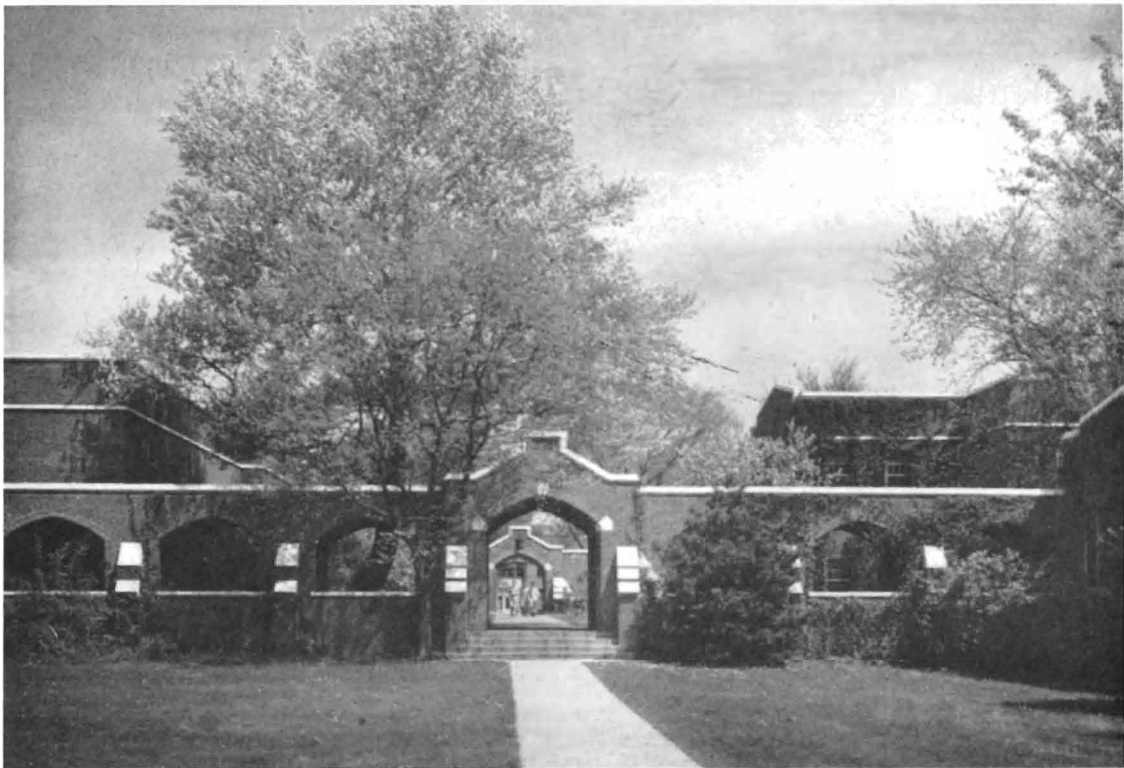
**Old Veterinary Hospital, erected at the same time as the Sanitary Building.**



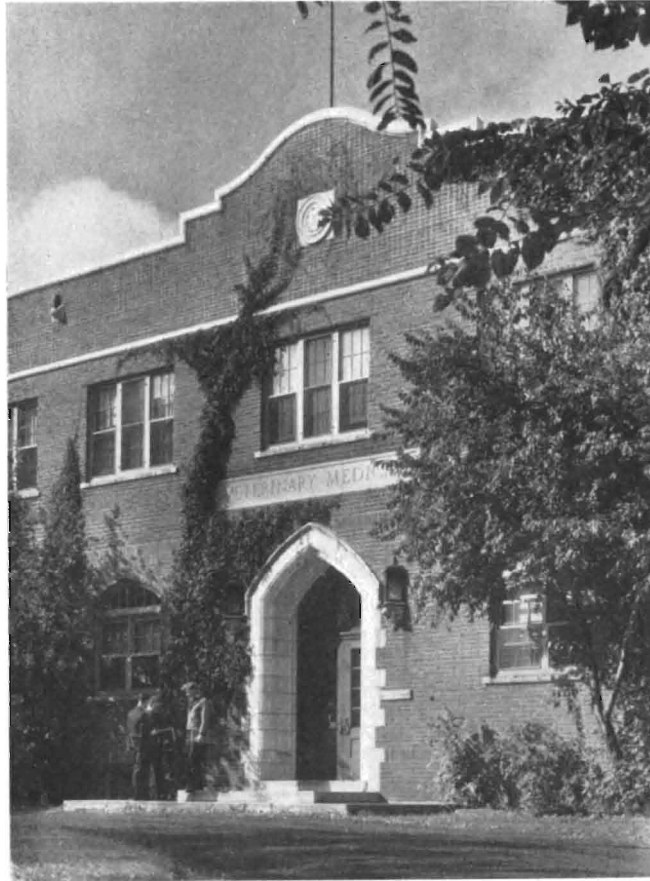
**Old Agriculture Hall, Veterinary classroom and laboratory quarters 1893-1912.**
