





1.2 Continuing Access Journals: During the Term, Licensee shall have access to the Continuing Access Journals listed in Section 3.1 first published during the Term. After the Term, Licensee shall have Continuing Access to the Continuing Access Journals first published during the Term, subject to all the terms and conditions of this License Agreement.

1.3 Backfile Access During the Term: In addition, during the Term only, Licensee will be granted access to the Content of the Continuing Access Journals titles published beginning the later of (a) four years prior to the Commencement Date or (b) the first date of publication.

2. Cessation of Publication; Transfers

2.1 **Cessation of Publication of Continuing Access Journals During the Term** If Licensor ceases to publish new Content for 3% or more of the Continuing Access Journals during any calendar year of the Term, whether because Licensor ceases to have publishing rights or because Licensor ceases to publish those Continuing Access Journals, upon Licensee’s written request, Licensor will, at Licensor’s sole option, offer to Licensee:

- (1) access to additional Content not presently licensed to Licensee with an approximate value equal to or greater than the value at the date of cessation of the Content associated with the discontinued Continuing Access Journals that was to be published from the date of cessation of publication through the end of the Term, or
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
